<p>Elementary (Grades Young Fives - 5th Grade):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Scale Down Option A - Fully Virtual 11/30/2020 - 12/18/2020 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Intent to return to Hybrid Instruction (2 days face-to-face; 3 days remote) on January 4, 2021 ● Continue with Option B - 100% Virtual
<p>Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Scale Down Option A - Fully Virtual 11/30/2020 - 12/18/2020 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Intent to return to Hybrid Instruction (2 days face-to-face; 3 days remote) on January 4, 2021 ● Continue with Option B - 100% Virtual
<p>High School (Grades 9 - 12):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Scale Down Option A - Per the MDHHS Executive Order, grades 9-12 must be fully virtual from November 18 - December 8. ● Continue to Scale Down Option A - Fully Virtual 11/30/2020 - 12/18/2020 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Intent to return to Hybrid Instruction (2 days face-to-face; 3 days remote) on January 4, 2021 ● Continue with Option B - 100% Virtual
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Opportunities for in-person instruction will be determined on a case-by-case basis for individual special education students, English Learners, and other special populations.
