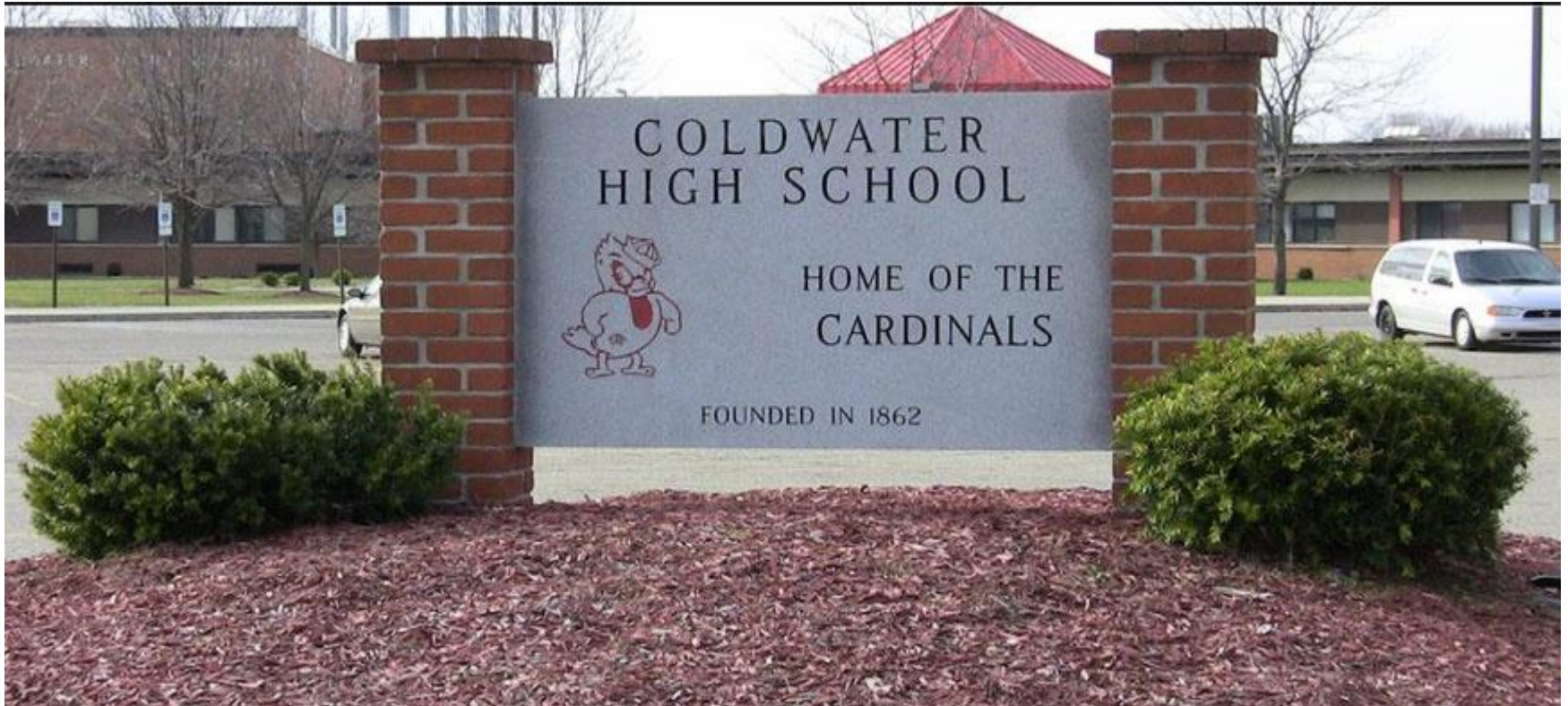
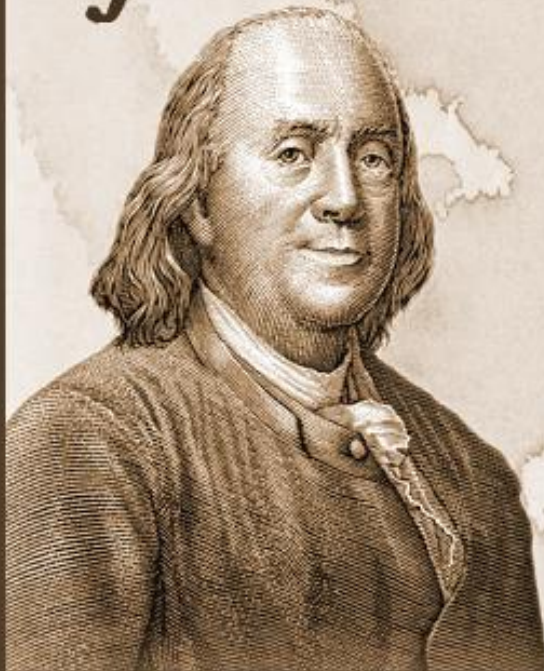

Required Credits to earn your diploma!

4 English Credits

Typically by grade level

4 Math Credits

Algebra, Geometry, Algebra 2, and one more

3 Science Credits

Biology of some kind, then a variety of paths and choices.
(A BACC program can count as 1 elective science course)

3 Social Studies Credits (Typically 6 semester classes)

9th grade History, World History A, World History B, American
History, American Economy, US Government

There are many paths based on the AP Social Studies Classes

Required Credits to earn your diploma!

Physical Education and Health Class

(There are some options for not taking these classes-ask your counselor)

Visual or Performing Arts Class (1 full credit)

(This could be any BACC program as well)

A World Language Other Than English (2 credits)

Most students take Spanish 1 and Spanish 2

Students must at least earn credit in Spanish 1 and then:

Pass the proficiency test

or

Earn credit in Spanish 2

or

COMPLETE a BACC program.

Dual Enrollment

Students who meet the qualifying scores on the PSAT or SAT can qualify for Dual Enrollment.

A Typical 10th Grade Schedule Might Include:

Math - Geometry

Science - Physical Science

English - English 10

Social Studies:

World History B and Modern American History

Then 2 hours of Elective Coursework

A Typical 11th Grade Schedule Might Include:

Math - Algebra 2

Science - Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy, Other
Science (or BACC Programming)

English - English 11

Social Studies:

Your classes are dependant on your other course needs.

Then 2-3 hours of Elective Coursework

Most BACC programs count as 3 hours of your day.

A Typical 12th Grade Schedule Might Include:

Math - You Need a minimum of 4 Math Credits

Science - You Need a minimum of 3 Science Credits

English - English 12 Course Choices

Social Studies:

The American Economy and US Government

Then 2-3 hours of Elective Coursework

Most BACC programs count as 3 hours of your day.
